You will collaborate closely with the leadership team to develop innovative new services and ways of working.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Oversee the day-to-day operations of financial inclusion, food insecurity, and employability projects.
- Ensure services are delivered to a high standard and align with The Good Shepherd's mission, values, and person-centred approach.
- Involve people that use our services in the development and improvement of projects and engage with Good Shepherds Service User Forum (SUF) and Lived Experience into Action Project (LEAP).
- Work closely with the Operations Manager to coordinate and improve service delivery managing a set of Key Performance Indicators for your services.
- Collaborate with the leadership team to develop and implement new services and ways of working.

- Monitor and evaluate project outcomes to ensure effective service delivery and identify areas for improvement.
- Develop and maintain relationships with stakeholders, including service users, staff, volunteers, and partner organisations.
- Attend and contribute to operational and strategic groups including the financial wellbeing strategy and food alliance.
- Manage and support a team of staff and volunteers, ensuring they are well-trained, motivated, and aligned with organisational values.
- Provide regular staff supervision and team meetings.
- Coordinate and manage external agencies that operate from the centre.
- Prepare and manage project budgets, ensuring financial sustainability and accountability.
- Ensure compliance with relevant legislation, regulations, and organisational policies including food safety regulations, health and safety, and safeguarding.
- Advocate for the needs and rights of service users within the community and with relevant authorities.
- Provide regular reports to the Operations Manager and other senior management on project progress and performance.
- Any other duties which reasonably fall within the range and responsibilities of this post, as requested by a member of the management team.
